APRIL UPDATE AT WARREN FARM

WE ARE BACK

Great news. We returned to Warren Farm on Saturday 15th April for the first time in 3 years.

The runway prepared for us by LBE contractors Amey is superb. Located in the same area which we previously used, it measures about 100mts x 40mts, and despite several years of neglect was surprisingly flat and smooth. No doubt it will improve further after it has been mown a few times.

This is, of course, only a temporary respite. The QPR redevelopment has been stalled by the legal actions brought by Save Warren Farm, and at the moment we cannot anticipate remaining at Warren Farm beyond the end of this year.

A few things to be aware of.

Firstly, Skylarks are nesting on parts of Warren Farm. Please take great care not to disturb them in any way, as they are a protected species.

Secondly, please keep within the boundary shown on the attached plan, and in particular stay well away from the horses in the field to our left. There are also sometimes horses in the field to our right.

Thirdly, we are endeavouring to have additional keys cut. Locking the gate is difficult, and the gate needs to be lifted as the hinges are worn. The gate **MUST** remain locked.
