

# WARREN FARM RADIO FLYERS



## FEBRUARY AT RECTORY PARK

Sorry if the newsletter is a bit abbreviated this month. With the end of flying at Warren Farm, and the atrocious weather, there has been little of note to photograph or report.

### TRANSFER TO RECTORY PARK

The transfer of flying activities to Rectory Park is now under way, although weekend flying will not be possible for a couple of weeks. Also, the park is currently waterlogged (sadly, like much of the UK), so only hand-launched models will be possible until it dries out. Please be extra careful if the electrics of your model are underneath – water & electrics do not mix!

The bookings office have advised that there is no Saturday football at Rectory Park, however we have noticed that there are several groups of footballers taking part in informal matches or training sessions in the area where we will be flying. LBE have printed a number of information sheets requesting that they relocate to other parts of the park. These will be distributed to the footballers by a council official before we begin our flying. We have suggested that this take place 1 week before our first flying session, as asking the footballers to move in mid-session will almost certainly aggravate them and make it far more difficult to secure their cooperation.

WFRF has copies of the information sheets, and has prepared a “FAQ” sheet. Both are attached, and we suggest that you print off several copies to give to anyone at Rectory Park who questions why we are there. If you do not have a printer, copies can be supplied.

In the meantime, it is our understanding that there will be no objection to models being flown at Warren Farm until such time as the move to Rectory Park is complete.

Finally, we now have keys to the Rectory Park toilets (including the ladies, so WAGs are now fully catered for), and copies will be made available.
