### ZIPPO'S CIRCUS

### FIELD CONDITION

Also, constant high speed aerobatics at low altitude can cause concerns from the public about disturbance to wildlife on the ground. This is especially the case with high performance models.

Please fly with respect for our environment, and do not give cause for complaint.
