FIELD CONDITION

The field has now received it's first cut of the year, so is in flyable condition, although still a little rough in places with a few rabbit holes. There are a number of as yet untried treatments on the market, including some based on garlic, however these are very expensive. We would, in any case, only be able to treat the location where the rabbits repeatedly excavate the same hole.

With regards to the mowing, the rough condition and grass length meant that LBE were only able to again use the rotary mower, however they hope to be able to revert to the cylinder mower, which we understand has rollers attached, in the near future. This machine has already been seen in other parts of the borough, so we live in hope.
