MORE VANDALISM

We are sorry to report further vandalism at the field. The toilet is now out of action until further notice.

The latest incident involved the toilet being blocked with a full toilet roll. Trying to remove it would be most unsanitary. We could contact Euroloo, however they will almost certainly declare the unit a write-off, incurring significant costs.

Replacing the toilet is pointless until such time as the culprit is found. We believe that these are targeted attacks, as previously the chain securing the toilet to a tree had been cut with bolt-cutters, and the chain removed. This is clearly more than common or garden vandalism, which is normally carried out by bored youngsters during the summer school holidays. They are unlikely to bring bolt-cutters to site.

This has been reported to Ealing Council, but to date no action has been taken.

In his weekly newsletter, Cllr. John Martin has mentioned suspicious activity at Warren Farm. His report is as follows :-

I have been notified this week of suspicious behaviour at Warren Farm car park which was reported to the police with follow up visits made and a warning issued. A reminder therefore to report all criminal activity (at Warren Farm or anywhere in the ward) to the police using 999 for any crime if it is happening and 101 for non-emergency. Please remember that police response depends on triaging of incidents at any given time but the above shows the value of reporting.
