RCC Tests

You will have seen in the latest copy of BMFA News that all members must pass the on-line RCC test by the end of November to fly legally. Some members (like me!) will have been given their RCC certificate based on passing the Fixed Wing A certificate. This RCC is provisional and only valid until the end of November, so you must take the on-line test. If you have problems getting on-line, you are welcome to come round to my place and do the test here. It is not difficult, and you will learn something while doing it!

Bob's Planes and Equipment
